Subject Changes to NABCO GT1175 Automatic Sliding Door Carrier for Sliding Panels		

Multiple improvements have been made to the NABCO GT1175 carrier for sliding panels. These changes begin in the third week of April and are projected to be fully implemented on all units by mid-May.

- 1) All carriers will now have an end cap on the trailing end.

- 2) The end cap on the strike end on single doors has been changed to eliminate interference with the header's end plate.

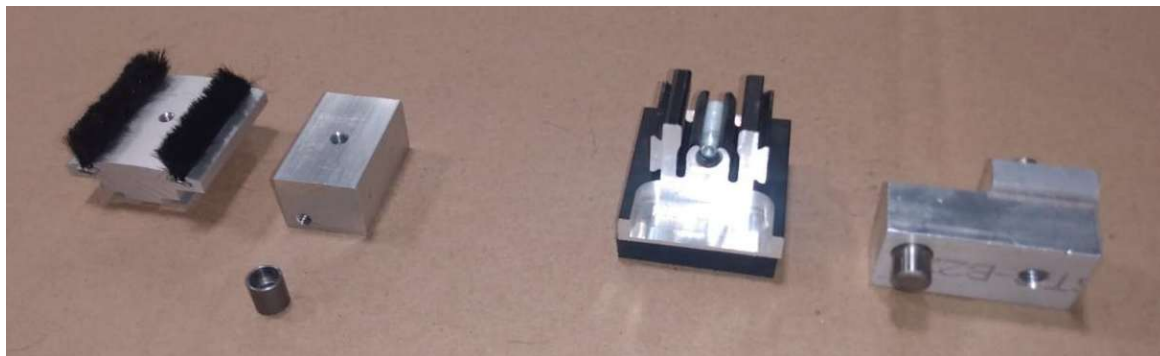
- 3) New anti-rise rollers. Instead of a slotted hole in the carrier, the roller now has an eccentric hub and adjusts just like the hanger rollers.

- 4) Stop pin assemblies for F86/8600 panic hardware are now adjustable for better alignment.
